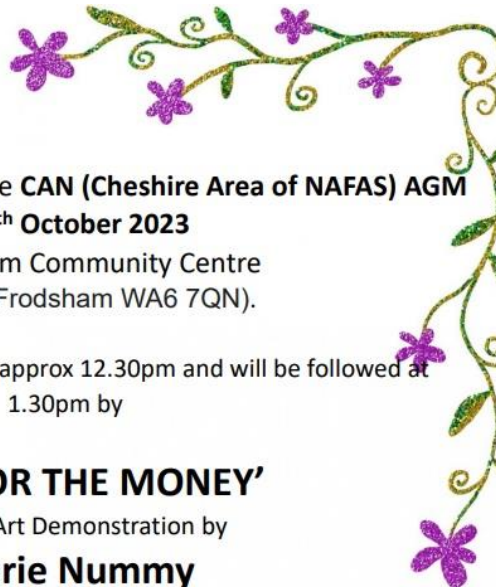


Hello everyone.

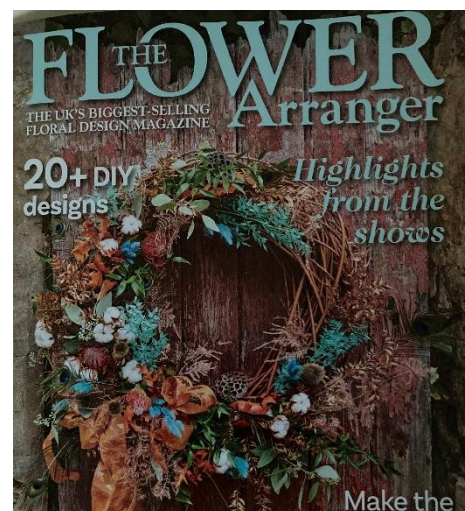

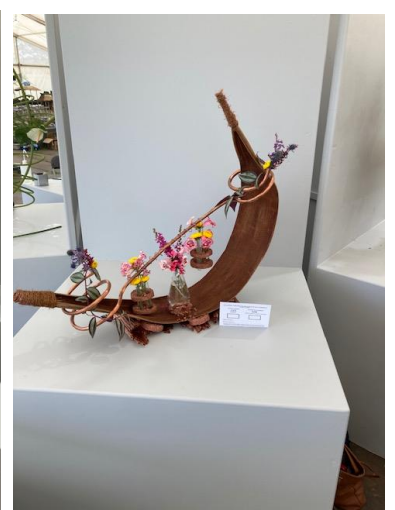

Christmas is coming.....

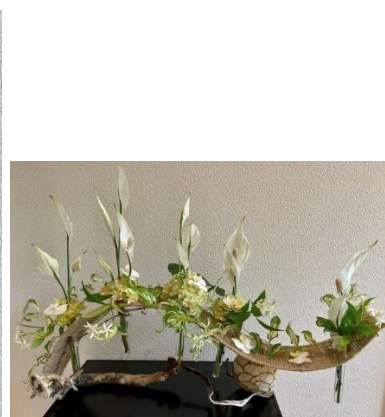
