...creating Christmas tree decorations out of birch twigs and other natural materials, under the tutelage of Judy Gratton (Area Support Officer and Young People's Representative) (Wistaston Flower Club). The 'How To' is shown below along with the creations by our young designers.



Christmas Mini Wreath

You will need:

A few twigs of silver birch, reel wire, scissors, items to decorate the wreath, glue Instructions

- 1. Take 3 or 4 of the twigs and bind together using the reel wire, add further twigs as required.
- 2. Once there is enough of the bound twigs to form a circle, bend into circle shape and continue to bind together until you have your wreath shape.
- 3. Cut the wire and tuck into the wreath.
- 4. Decorate and enjoy!
