Stewarding at the Show - Could you Help?

The Show Team would like your help please. Maureen Hernon (Sale) the Steward's Secretary writes:

'Once again, we are asking Flower Clubs to provide members who would like to steward at the Royal Cheshire Show. The stewards are extremely important to us, as it means that we have a friendly face to interact with our visitors, and their help is gratefully acknowledged.

We are offering 4 time slots and would like volunteers to sign up for any 2

of them. The slots are:

Morning: 10.00 am – 11.30 pm. AND 11.30am – 1.00pm. Afternoon: 1.00 pm – 2.30 pm. AND 2.30pm – 4.00pm.

We also would like volunteers to help with 'children's hands-on' activities as well as stewarding. The task of stewarding entails sitting or standing in an allotted position and being ready to answer the visitors' questions, discussing Flower Clubs with those who show an interest, and directing them to the Publicity table if required and distributing the voting slips for "The People's Choice Award". This has proved to be very popular and provides a good opportunity to engage with the visitors. The success of this award depends on the stewards giving out lots of voting cards and persuading visitors to vote for their favourite designs. It encourages people to look more closely at the exhibits and appreciate the work involved. It is also necessary to discourage members of the public from touching or moving any component of the exhibit, explaining that some plant materials may cause allergies, and pointing out interesting features in the exhibit. A sash or badge will be provided to identify stewards. Tea and coffee making facilities are available to use before and after each shift, but drinks not to be brought to stewarding positions.

Stewards will receive a free entry ticket a few days before the show. All parking is free and disabled parking is close to the entrance. Should the volunteer have to cancel for any reason it is important that they let the steward's secretary know as soon as possible.

Willow stems will be provided. Please bring a 26cm pot and some dry compost + secateurs.



"OLYMPIAD IN PARIS"

Class 1. Rings of Friendship: An exhibit.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

Class 2. Olympic Champion: A bouquet.

Space allowed: width 60cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

Class 3. The Cup That Cheers: A petite exhibit.

Space allowed: width 25cm, depth 25cm, height 37cm.

Class 4. Flying the Flag: A pavé exhibit.

Foliage to predominate.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

Class 5. In Balance: A contemporary exhibit.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

Class 6. Going for Gold: An exhibit.

Event to be depicted.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

This is a novice class and is only open to exhibitors who have not been placed

first at a previous Nantwich Show Floral Art competition.

School Entries

Design an Olympic medal (can be a craft item)

Please contact the Floral Art Secretary for further information.

IMPORTANT

- 1. All sizes are approximate.
- 2. All classes are to be brought in prepared and ready to assemble.
- 3. All classes are to be staged on tabling approximately 75cm high.
- 4. The staging and backcloth are of a mushroom colour.
- 5. The backcloth will be approximately 100cm above the table. Exhibits may exceed this if required.
- 6. Nothing is to be attached to the backcloth.
- 7. The use of aerosol sprays inside the marquee is not permitted.
- 8. Only one entry per class.
- 9. All exhibits left at owner's risk.

RULES

All exhibits will be judged in accordance with NAFAS 'Competitions Manual' Third Edition 2015. The judges' decision will be final.

An exhibit is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified in a show schedule.

Exhibits must be staged at the show venue unless otherwise stated in the show schedule.

Disqualification will take place for the following reasons:-

- Failure to comply with any specific requirement of a class as stated in the show schedule e.g. the measurements or the components.
- Inclusion of fresh plant material that does not have the roots or the cut ends of stems in water retaining material. Exceptions: Air plants, cacti, fruits, fungi, grass turf, lichen, moss, succulents, vegetables and

long-lasting plant material WHICH WILL REMAIN TURGID FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW. (Definition of turgid – the state of firmness of plant tissue relating from adequate moisture causing the plant cells to be fully expanded).

• Inclusion of artificial plant material (unless specifically allowed in the show schedule).

For further details and definitions, please refer to the NAFAS Competitions Manual Third Edition 2015, in accordance with which all classes will be judged.

STAGING

Exhibits may be staged between 1.00pm and 3.00pm on Tuesday 30th July 2024.

Exhibits may be removed after 5.30pm on show day and must be cleared by 6.30pm.

JUDGING

Judging will commence at 3.30pm on Tuesday 30th July 2024.

In addition, Class 1 "Rings of Friendship" will also be judged as "People's Choice" and voted on by the general public. Voting to close at 3.00pm on show day.

Prizes for all classes: 1st £10, 2nd £7, 3rd £4
