






#### **Southport Flower Show 2025**







Left: Louise Jones' design 'Spiralling out of Control'



#### 55<sup>™</sup> 'Emerald' Anniversary AGM - Flower Arranging Competition

All classes are titled 'Emerald'

- Class 1 for those that have not won an individual award (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> or special) at an Area show
- Class 2 for those that have won an individual award (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> or special) at an Area show but not at a National OR WAFA Show
- Class 3 for those that have won an individual award (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> or special) at a National or WAFA Show

All Classes are open to affiliated members of a Cheshire Club

The competition will be held in the small hall at Frodsham community centre on Thursday October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2025

#### **Competition Rules**

To be viewed and judged from the front

Exhibits to be staged on tables covered with pale green fabric. There will be two exhibits per table

#### There will be NO background drapes

Space allowed: width 60 cm, depth 60 cm, height optional

Table height 70 cm

All measurements are approximate

All exhibits to be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual 4<sup>th</sup> edition 2023

All exhibits must be the unaided work of the competitor and must be brought ready assembled

All exhibits must be staged within the space allowed

All exhibits will be staged under fluorescent lighting

Places are limited. Entries to be submitted by email on the attached form to <a href="mailto:secretary@nafascheshire.org.uk">secretary@nafascheshire.org.uk</a> NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 4<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER. If oversubscribed, places will be allocated by ballot. All entrants will be notified by Friday September 11<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Staging and Judging**

Staging time will be 10.30am - 11.00am on October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Judging will take place at 11.30am by Pam Fleming-Williams

#### **Prizes and Awards**

Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class, Best In Show and the winner of the People's Choice vote

AGM Attendees will be able to vote for the People's Choice between 12.30pm and 1.15pm, **prior** to the judged results being released

N.B. If a competitor is staying for the AGM demonstration, they must purchase a ticket.
